In undertaking an ICENI Centre Fellowship at ESNEFT our commitment to you is that you will have the following opportunities within your speciality:

- Working alongside a team of experienced Trauma & Orthopaedic (T&O) surgeons within a range of sub-specialities
- Exposure to rotating sub-speciality posts including:
 - * Knee Surgery and Sports Injuries – Arthroscopy, Ligament reconstruction (including Multi-Ligament), Meniscal repair, Cartilage Surgery, Primary and Revision Arthroplasty
 - * Lower Limb Arthroplasty – Primary and Revision Hip and Knee Surgery, Hip Arthroscopy (dependant on rotation postings)
 - * Upper Limb Surgery which will include Shoulder Surgery, Elbow Surgery and Hand/Wrist Surgery
- Exposure to General and Sub-speciality Trauma
- Access to a range of courses and other seminars, as available
- Opportunities to take part in supervised audits and research projects
- Generous support from Consultant Educational/Clinical Supervisors with an annual appraisal
